

No outside help from non Cav people, but Cav riders can help Cav riders.

So if you have a buddy riding Cav, they can hold your horse and you can share food. Whatever is used during the ride must be carried with the rider. You can't stash stuff. For example, you can't leave your bag of grain at the away VC. You have to carry it with you all day.

Hay or feed at vet checks left by other riders may not be used.

No supplies can be picked up or discarded during the ride. All materials, except trash, must be carried throughout the ride. All trash must be disposed of in proper receptacles.

One bucket and some hay may be placed at the finish line for use at the End of the ride.

Specially designated crews areas must be used. These areas will be stocked with water and buckets for horses and water for people.

Cavalry horses can drink and eat from all natural food sources. In addition, they can partake of Ride Management water troughs on trail. At no time, should they take water or feed from other riders or pit crews.

Cavalry horses will be marked with the letter "C" in front of their ride numbers.

Lost shoes must be replaced by the Cavalry rider and with tools carried by them on the ride. Use of a farrier will cause the rider to drop out of the Cavalry division.

Cav riders cannot sit on anything man made. You can sit on natural Objects like stumps or rocks.
