The U.S. EPA is comprised of more than 17,000 professionals working across the nation to usher in a green economy, and address health threats from toxins and pollution. As Administrator, Jackson is focus on core issues of protecting air and water quality, preventing exposure to toxic contamination in our communities, reducing greenhouse gases, following the best science, and adherence to the rule of law. She has made it a priority to focus on vulnerable groups including children, the elderly, and low-income communities. Before becoming EPA's Administrator, Jackson served as Chief of Staff to NJ Governor Corzine and Commissioner of NJ's Department of Environmental Protection (DEP). Prior to joining DEP, she worked for 16 years with EPA. Jackson graduated from Tulane University and earned a MS in chemical engineering from Princeton University. She was born in Pennsylvania and grew up a proud resident of New Orleans.
