

Instructions for Maple Homework

I. Obtaining your homework

1. Go to the webpage <http://www.math.ncsu.edu/calculus> .
2. Click on "Students"
3. In the table of contents click on "Maple Homework". You will be sent to your personalized Maple homework page.
4. Click on the blue "HomeworkX" link in the left column, where X denotes the number of the Homework assignment. Download the file and save it to disk.

II. Completing your Maple Homework

1. Maple is available on all campus computers that are connected to the unity network.
2. Start up the Maple program.
3. Click on "file" in the top menu bar and open the file you saved to disk.
4. Complete the problems and save the file to disk

III. Submitting your work for grading

1. Return to your customized Maple homework page.
2. Click on the "mini_submit" line that is in the same row as the homework you wish to submit.
3. Click on the "browse" button and find the Homework file you saved to disk.
4. Once the name of your file appears in the text window next to the browse button, click on the "upload" button.
5. A new page will appear, and you can click on the "homework" link to return you to your Maple homework page.
6. You should see a horizontal table with a list of grades for the homework you just submitted. If you don't see the new grade list click on the "refresh" button in your browser.
