For the review sessions, we prepared exam questions which we used in a "spelling bee" type game. Just by asking questions and trying to answer them, I was able to re-learn the material and retain it more effectively. He also required us to watch and comment on the 3 Presidential and 1 Vice-Presidential debates. Normally I would have never watched these debates, but because of his assignment, I watched them and became more knowledgeable and active in the 2008 Presidential race. It was a very educational and rewarding experience for me that was inspired by Dr. Campbell.
